'Water for women, Women for water' campaign

Coimbatore, Nov 10: In a bid to create awareness about the importance of water conservation, a campaign titled 'Water for women, Women for water' was organised under the aegis of Amrut 2.0 of the Union Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs and the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) at Velliangadu water recycling plant area. About 100 women self help groups (SHG) were taken around the Pillur drinking water project to have a peek at the process of water being recycled for distribution to the residents in Coimbatore city. In this connection, a workshop was also conducted by the Coimbatore Corporation Assistant Engineer Sathyamoorthy. They were shown about how the water is processed at the recycling plant before distribution. This event gave an insight to the women self help group members about the functioning of the water recycling plant. Corporation officials were also present on the occasion.



The women's wing of Erode south district BJP led by Punitham Iyappan staged a demonstration condemning Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar speaking ill of women-folk thereby bringing disgrace to them. Modakurichi MLA Dr C Saraswathy, Erode south district BJP president V C Vedanandam, State women's wing secretary Mohanapriya were present. The agitators sought the resignation of Bihar CM

Institution blamed for the ragging incident

M Rafi Ahmed VAO, NGO representative stated that over the last five and a half years, at least 25 students have died by suicide after they were subjected to ragging and the complaints were registered with the central body between January 1, 2018 to August 1, 2023. There is no meaning in giving diktats to colleges under its fold to display 'Anti-Ragging Board' inside the campus. What's the use without action? As far as the Coimbatore PSG College of Technology incident, the victim native of Tirupur was allegedly humiliated and subjected to verbal and physical assault by the accused students for not giving them money to buy liquor. Thanks to the swift action by the Peelamedu police in nabbing the seven accused students and filing an FIR against them under 8 Sections and later remanded to judicial custody. Citizens' Voice Club president C M Jayaraman said that this incident should be an eye-opener to other institutions to be active in taking action to prevent ragging in any form taking place inside the campus. What's the anti-ragging committee should meet atleast once in a quarter to interact with the students. It may be noted that the Coimbatore City Police Commissioner V Balakrishnan launched the 'Police Bro' scheme to end drug menace among the college students in July this year. Sooner the better for the CoP to use the 'Police Bro' system for anti-ragging initiatives.

Review meet with noon meal section officers

Coimbatore, Nov 10: Additional Director, Social Welfare and Women Empowerment S P Karthikaa told the Personal Assistants to collector (Noon meal) besides Deputy BDOs (Noon Meal), Corporation and Municipal noon meal section officers not to compromise in the quality of eggs and other food items supplied under the Noon Meal scheme.



She was chairing a review meeting with noon meal officers belonging to Coimbatore, Tirupur, Erode, Nilgiris, Namakkal, Kallakurichi, Salem, Krishnagiri and Dharmapuri districts at Coimbatore collectorate in the presence of District Collector Kranti Kumar Pati when she advised the officials to be cautious while procuring eggs and

added that there shouldn't any complaints. Since it's the rainy season now, she told the officials to ensure lorries transporting eggs must be fully covered with tarpaulins and distribution of eggs must be streamlined sans any discrepancies whatsoever. The state officials asked

the school noon meal organisers to receive after checking the quality of eggs and to use only hot water. Samples of food items must be tested at frequent intervals and the noon meal organisers must behave properly. Collector said that breakfast scheme works must be reviewed by the

monitoring committee meeting on a weekly basis. Earlier, she inspected a few school noon meal centres in the city and had a peek at the eggs for its quality. In the event of any stale eggs, she told the organisers to get it replaced from the contractors supplying eggs to schools.



Residents up in arms against water stagnation

Salem, Nov 10: Corporation Commissioner Balachandran visited the inundated areas due to heavy rains a couple of days ago. The low lying areas at Sivadhapuram on Siddhar Koil main road witnessed dwellings under a sheet of water and inmates facing untold hardship.

All because of lack of desilting of the sewage channel resulting in rainwater flowing into it with the sewage channel getting choked. Agitated over this sorry state of affairs, councillor Selvaraj alongwith Sivadhapuram residents staged a picketing. They said that despite complaining about the water stagnation during heavy rains, the corporation failed to take any action. The Corporation assured the councillor and the residents that a storm
