Pune Shree Omkareshwar temple

Architectural & spiritual legacy on banks of Mutha River

Nestled in the heart of Pune at Shaniwar Peth, along the serene banks of the Mutha River, stands the magnificent Shree Omkareshwar Devasthan — a timeless symbol of devotion, architecture, and spiritual legacy. This sacred shrine predates even the present-day Kashi Vishwanath Temple in Varanasi, reflecting the rich heritage and deep spiritual roots of Maharashtra.

History
The temple owes its origin to Shivrambhat, a devout philosopher and spiritual seeker. In his quest for a tranquil place for meditation, Shivrambhat discovered the ancient Ganeshkind temple at the foot of Chatushrungi Hill, which lay in ruins. Between 1730 and 1734, he undertook its restoration, turning it into a haven for contemplation.

Divine discovery
Around 1735, after constructing a new Ganesh temple, pilgrims began flocking to the site. To meet their needs, Shivrambhat excavated an abandoned well to provide drinking water. To his astonishment, he uncovered large pots (hande) filled with gold mohurs (ancient coins). Aware of the law that such treasure belongs to the state, the saintly

Shivrambhat presented the find to the ruling Peshwa.

Impressed by his integrity, the Peshwa offered the treasure to Shivrambhat as a gift. The ascetic politely declined, stating that as a *sannyasi*, material wealth held no value for him. Moved by his renunciation, the Peshwa asked how the gold should be used. Shivrambhat expressed his heartfelt desire: to build a grand temple dedicated to Lord Shiva, since the two ancient temples of Mahadev in Pune—Punyeshwar and Narayaneshwar—had been desecrated and converted into mosques over five centuries ago during the invasions.

The Peshwa approved the request and granted the entire right bank of the Mutha River for the temple's construction. The temple was built during the reign of Thorle Bajirao Peshwa, but since Bajirao was often away on military campaigns, the responsibility fell on his brother Chimaji Appa, a devoted follower of Omkareshwar. Chimaji Appa not only oversaw the temple's construction but also chose the site based on Shivrambhat's vision that Lord Shiva, the Lord of Destruction, resides near cremation grounds—thus selecting the river bend near a traditional pyre site.

Construction began on October 26, 1736,



and the sanctum sanctorum (*Garbhagriha*) was consecrated on June 18, 1738. After fulfilling his sacred mission, Shivrambhat took Sanjeyan Samadhi at Someshwar Temple in Pashan on April 15, 1751. His son, Krishna Bhat, later completed the meditation chambers (ovaries), the main entrance, and the Nagarkhana (drum house) by 1758.

Notably, Chimaji Appa's Samadhi lies just outside the Omkareshwar temple, marking his deep devotion. His wife, Annapurnabai, performed Sati on his funeral pyre in 1740, an act that remains etched in the temple's history.

Cradle of revolution
Beyond its religious significance, the temple also played a quiet yet powerful role in India's freedom struggle.

Architecture
The temple showcases a stunning fusion of Maratha architecture and Nagara-style design. The elegant *Shikhara* (spire) is adorned with carvings of deities including Lord Ganesh, Dattaguru, Sage Vyasa, and others. The grand verandas and intricately carved columns—ranging in shapes from circular and square to polygonal—enhance the temple's majesty. At its heart lies the Shivaling, enshrined in the sanctum, radiating a sublime spiritual energy that invites introspection and divine connection.

Poojas
Devotees perform various Abhishekams and Poojas throughout the year, with the most unique among them being the Chakka Pooja. In this ritual, different forms of Lord Shiva are sculpted using thick yogurt (chakka) on the sacred Shivaling—a visual and spiritual delight for devotees.

Deities
The temple's presiding deity is Lord Shiva, revered here as Omkareshwar—the blue-throated (*Neelkanth*) destroyer of evil. The complex also houses smaller shrines dedicated to Lord Ganesh, Goddess Durga, Lord Vishnu, Lord Shani, and Lord Hanuman, making it a confluence of divine energies.

Benefits
Praying and meditating at this temple, which is dedicated to Lord Shiva, is believed to offer numerous benefits for devotees. The temple gives spiritual enlightenment and a beacon for those seeking solace and growth. Devotees believe that worshipping Omkareshwar can grant respite from evil, bestow blessings of health and happiness, and foster inner peace.

Shree Omkareshwar Devasthan stands as a beacon of spiritual devotion, historical resilience, and architectural splendor. No. SEK/DPC/ACS/HT/T. Audit/HT. Sc. No. 247/D. No. 16, dated 29.08.2016, and quash the same as being arbitrary and illegal and other reliefs as prayed for in M. P. No. 1 of 2025.

1. Mahashivratri – Once marked by the majestic Ati-Rudra Swahakar, performed by 110 priests in earlier times, this remains the most important festival dedicated to Lord Shiva.
